

Live like a Pioneer!!


The docents of Sutter's Fort State Historic Park invite you to join them at an authentic "Trapper's Camp."

The different "stations" your students will observe have been designed to cover many aspects of the California fourth and fifth grade curriculum standards for History and Social Science, including: California native people, western migration, daily life, pioneer women, native plants and how they were used, and how and why animals were trapped.
