Commercial Boating


The lands known as Auburn State Recreation Area and Folsom Lake State Recreation Area are hereby closed to use, entry or occupancy by Commercial Boating Companies.

Commercial Boating is defined as any company or entity that transports persons on waters of the North, Middle or South Forks of the American River for a fee, regardless of profit.

This closure is placed into effect immediately to insure the health and safety of persons using the area, as well as, protection of the property of the Department of Parks and Recreation.

Exception: With a State-approved Concession Agreement, which clearly defines boating activities permitted on the forenamed rivers, and obtained by individual Companies/Entities from the Department of Parks and Recreation on an annual basis, Commercial Boating Companies/Entities will be allowed to operate within the Auburn and Folsom Lake State Recreation Areas. All use shall be within the conditions specified on such permit.

Exception to this order may only be granted in writing by the Gold Fields District Superintendent at 7755 Folsom-Auburn Road, Folsom, CA 95630.
Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of the law.




