**Temporary Closure
Sophia Parkway Vehicle Access and
Mormon Island Auxiliary Dam Crossing**

The Sophia Parkway Vehicle Access, Mormon Island Auxiliary Dam (MIAD) and adjacent trails within Folsom Lake State Recreation Area (FLSRA) will be temporarily closed to public entry beginning April 9, 2024.

During this closure, public access is not permitted on MIAD, dirt trails or service roads below and parallel to the MIAD, as depicted on the attached map.


No detour or trail connections will be available within FLSRA between Folsom Point and the Sophia Parkway vehicle access area. For the safety of the visiting public, these areas are closed due to the Folsom Dam Raise Construction Project. This closure will remain in effect until the project is complete.

Exceptions:

1. Employees, officers, contractors, lessees, permittees of the State Department of Parks and Recreation, US Bureau of Reclamation, Army Corp. of Engineers and inspectors entering the area on official business.
2. Those non-employees accompanied by the above-described officials who may be in the area on official business.

Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Gold Fields District Superintendent at 7755 Folsom-Auburn Road, Folsom, CA 95630.
Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.


