Temporary Closure Trail Segments Between Mt. Oak Court and Folsom Lake Crossing

The trail segments between Mountain Oak Court and Folsom Lake Crossing will be closed within Folsom Lake State Recreation Area. These temporary trail closures include the American River Bike Trail and other recreational trails as identified on the attached map. Closure will be daily, from December 4, 2023, though December 8, 2023, from 6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

For the safety of the visiting public, these trail segments will be closed to all public entry during a fuel reduction project. Closure notices will be posted accordingly at various trail locations.

Exceptions:

- Employees, officers, contractors, lessees, and permittees of the State Department of Parks and Recreation, US Bureau of Reclamation entering the area on official business.
- 2. Those non-employees accompanied by the above-described officials who may be in the area on official business.

This order is in effect for the health and safety of persons, property, and resources.

Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Gold Fields District Superintendent at 7755 Folsom-Auburn Road, Folsom, CA 95630. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.


