**Temporary Closure of American River Bike Trail
Negro Bar to Call Box 28**

The American River Bike Trail from southwest end of Negro Bar to Call Box 28, as depicted on the attached map, will be closed to all public use and entry from Monday, August 19, 2019, until further notice.

This closure is for the protection of the public during bluff stabilization and trail repair work that will occur along this segment of trail.

Exceptions:

1. Employees, officers, contractors, lessees, and permittees of the California Department of Parks and Recreation and of the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation entering the area on official business.
2. Those non-employees accompanied by the above-described officials who may be in the area on official business.

Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Gold Fields District Superintendent at 7755 Folsom-Auburn Road, Folsom, CA 95630.

Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
