### **Annual Peregrine Falcon Closure**

### **February 1<sup>st</sup> – July 31<sup>st</sup>**

The seasonal closure of the “Castle Rock” formation located in Mount Diablo State Park preserves and protects sensitive peregrine falcon nesting habitat that is unique to this particular area. The closure is in effect annually from February 1<sup>st</sup> through July 31<sup>st</sup>. During the closure period, all park visitors are prohibited from accessing the area. An alternative climbing area in the park is in the Rock City Area, commonly referred to as the “Boy Scout Rocks Formation”. We appreciate everyone’s cooperation to protect the parks natural resources!

DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT'S ORDER No. 660-16-040

**Mount Diablo State Park  
Posted Order- Castle Rock**

1. In order to preserve and protect Sensitive Peregrine Falcon nesting habitat, the area in Mount Diablo State Park known as Castle Rock is closed to all pedestrians, equine, bicycles or any other mode of transportation, annually from February 1, through July 31 of the same year. The Castle Rock closure area is defined as park lands East of Stage Fire Road, North of the Sunset Trail, West of Falcon Fire Road, and South of the park boundary. A map of this closure area is attached and posted at all Posting locations and in the closure area.
2. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private, contractual, residential or property rights.
3. Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Bay Area District Superintendent, 845 Casa Grande Road, Petaluma California 94954.
4. Nothing herein shall be construed to be in derogation of other provisions of law.
