

The idea behind this project is "beyond adobe bricks," meaning we are encouraging students to approach history using critical thinking skills and sensitivity to multiple perspectives. We hope to see projects that use a variety of formats including writing, media, and art to consider how the complexity of the Mission period impacted the lives of the peoples of California at that time.
