Student Living History Program 2018

Dear teachers, parents and educational leaders,

Fort Tejon State Historic Park Offers a unique overnight hands-on Student Living History Program (SLHP) for 4th, 5th, and 8th graders. We invite you to enroll your class in our one-of-a-kind learning experience. Take your students on a trip back in time to 1850s California and experience the everyday life of a soldier stationed at Fort Tejon, a Western U.S. Army outpost.

The Spring season runs March through May. Programs run for two days and one night, running Monday through Tuesday or Thursday through Friday. Please submit your preferred and alternate trip dates as soon as possible, as reservations are made on a **first come, first serve basis**. Apply for this program by submitting the enclosed Program Reservation Form and a \$100.00 non-refundable deposit (per trip)

This year we have a choice of activities at the carpentry station. Teachers can choose “Tools that built Fort Tejon” where in students use a variety of historically accurate hand tools, or the individual toolbox where schools are required to provide materials, and each student makes their very own toolbox. We also have an interactive scavenger hunt with map, and an activity book as supplemental activities.

Fort Tejon’s non-profit partner, Fort Tejon Historical Association, is offering a limited number of bus scholarships to defray transportation costs. Title 1 schools receive first priority for SLHP bus scholarships, but other schools will be considered.

Student Living History Program requirements and facts:

- The SLHP is an overnight experience, from about 9am to approximately 11am the next day.
- There is a \$50.00 fee per student and a \$30.00 fee per adult. Program materials and two meals (supper and breakfast) are included. Participants must provide their own individual or group lunches.
- A \$100.00 non-refundable deposit is required. Checks should be made payable to: *California State Parks*
- A **minimum of 20 students and a maximum of 40 students** per program, not including adults.
- A **minimum of 6 adult assistants and 1 teacher** per program must be present during the entire program.
- A **maximum of 12 adult assistants** for overnight accommodations.
- Adult involvement is necessary for a successful program. **Teachers, parents and adult assistants must attend a mandatory pre-program training at Fort Tejon SHP.** This three-hour training workshop will be conducted 9:00am to 12:00pm. Three trainings are available on the:

A minimum of 6 adults and 1 teacher per program must be present during the entire program. A maximum of 12 parent / adult chaperones for overnight accommodations.
