Fort Tejon State Historic Park offers a unique hands-on Summer Living History Program (SLHP) for children. We are now offering our Summer 2013 schedule of programs. Fort Tejon SHP invites you to enroll your class in our one-of-a-kind experience. Take your campers on a trip back in time to 1850s California and discover the everyday life of a soldier stationed at Fort Tejon, a U.S. Army outpost.

The Summer Living History Program are offered in the month of August 2013. Programs are day programs run from 9 AM to 3:30 PM. Please pick dates that best meet your group schedule and submit your preferred and alternate dates as soon as possible. Please do not delay in making your reservation, as reservations are on a **first come, first serve basis**.

Apply for the program by submitting the enclosed Program Reservation Form and a \$25.00 deposit per group.

Summer Living History Program requirements and facts:

- The program begins around 9:00 a.m. and ends at approximately 3:30 PM.
- There is a **\$15.00 fee per camper**
- A \$25.00 non-refundable deposit is required per class with your Summer Living History Program application. The balance of the program fee is due upon arrival at the park for your program.
- Checks should be made payable to: *California Dept. of Parks and Recreation*
- Minimum of **20** and Maximum of **40** campers per program.
A minimum of **6** counselors must be present during the entire program.
- Camp counselors are required to assist park staff at activity stations
- If your Summer Living History Program application arrives after the program calendar is full we will keep your request on a waiting list. In this case your deposit check will be returned.

I look forward to seeing you and your campers at Fort Tejon State Historic Park this upcoming Summer for this fun learning experience.
