No access by foot, horseback or vehicle is allowed.
 - A. The property known as Coyote Canyon from Lower Willows to Middle Willows in San Diego County.
 1. Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Colorado Desert District, 200 Palm Canyon Drive, Borrego Springs, CA 92004-5005.
 2. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contracts or property rights.
 3. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions by law.
