These are free events for the public. Once you enter the beach, turn left and park at the south end of the first parking lot. The programs will take place in the Campground Center.

Directions to the State Beach

The entrance to Bolsa Chica State Beach is located off Pacific Coast Highway between Warner and Seapoint.

From North-

Take the 405 South and exit Bolsa Chica Road. Stay on Bolsa Chica until you get to Warner Avenue. Turn right on Warner. Turn left on PCH. Turn right at the first street light to enter the State Beach.

From South-

By car: Take the 405 North and exit Warner Avenue. Turn left on PCH. Turn right at the first street light to enter the State Beach.

Once Inside the State Beach

Most Bolsa Chica events will take place inside or around the Visitor Center in the Lifeguard Headquarters building, which is located by the entrance. Check with entrance staff for precise locations.

Junior Rangers

Junior Rangers is designed for children ages **7-12**. Monday & Wednesday programs are from 10 am - 11 am; please call for Friday start times. All Junior Ranger programs begin at the Bolsa Chica Lifeguard Headquarters building. Junior Ranger programs are free to the public. These programs are designed to help children discover the rich natural and cultural heritage preserved in parks. Possible topics are: ecology, the wetlands, geology, marine mammals, beach animals, plants of the beach, and more!

Each Jr. Ranger must be **signed up** by a parent or guardian. This may be done before the beginning of the program.

A parent or guardian should be available at the beach during Jr. Ranger programs in case of an emergency.
