- 1 The Bane Canyon Entrance Road in Chino Hills State Park is closed to the public during road construction improvements from the intersection at 4721 Sapphire Road in the city of Chino Hills to Lower Aliso trail at Bane Canyon near the Rolling M Ranch within the park. All vehicles, bicyclists, pedestrians and equestrians are prohibited from entering the area at all times until construction is complete.
- 2 Exceptions to this posted order may only be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Inland Empire District, 17801 Lake Perris Dr, Perris, CA 92571.
- 3 Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contract or property rights.
- 4 Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.


