THE HOUSE OF THE LORD HAS FALLEN. – During the recent rains, the adobe wall on the north side of the New Catholic Church, became so undermined by the washing of the foundation, that on New Year's night, about half of it fell with a crash that could be heard all over town, leaving that holy edifice open to remark, and the winds from the north. The building would have been finished long since, but from the fact that the resident *Padre* made himself so obnoxious to the Protestant portion of the community – by whom a large part of the funds for its erection was contributed – by his weekly denunciations of Free Masonry, that he couldn't squeeze another dime out of them.
