1. In order to ensure the safety and health of persons, preserve the property within the California State Park System, and guard portions thereof, I hereby declare the following areas closed to public use, entry, and occupancy and all traffic, to include foot, horseback, vehicles, or other forms of transportation until the completion of the San Diego Gas and Electric Circuit 79A project:
 - A. Lookout Fire Road from Paso Picacho to Cuyamaca Peak.
 - B. Hual-Cu-Cuish Staging Area.
2. Only designated State Park personnel, emergency personnel, SDG&E and their contractors, and communication tower personnel, on official business, are authorized to enter the closed area at any time.
3. The District Superintendent, or designee, may grant exceptions to this order as determined to be necessary for the proper administration of Cuyamaca Rancho State Park and to protect the safety and welfare of its visitors, employees and resources. All exceptions must be obtained in writing by contacting the District Superintendent, Colorado Desert District, 200 Palm Canyon Drive, Borrego Springs, CA 92004-5005, (760) 767-4037.
4. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law, existing contracts, or property rights previously granted.
