State Grant Funds Awarded for Rehabilitation of Hiller Park Loop Trail

SACRAMENTO -- The California Department of Parks and Recreation today announced the allocation of \$72,000 for the rehabilitation and upgrading of the Hiller Park Loop Trail in McKinleyville.

The grant was awarded through the non-motorized trails grant program of the Park Bond Act of 2000. The funds will give McKinleyville Parks and Recreation, in partnership with the California Conservation Corps, the opportunity to complete work to make the main trail ADA accessible, as well as place signage and develop an interpretive guide for visitors.

The Hiller Loop Trail runs throughout Hiller Park, connecting to the McKinleyville Land Trust coastal property through an existing trail system. It intersects with the Hammond Coastal Trail, a Class 1 bicycle path that runs through the park.
