Old Sacramento State Historic Park Concession Opportunity Public Input Meeting

OLD SACRAMENTO STATE HISTORIC PARK -- California State Parks will be accepting comments regarding the Silver Palace Café and catering services for the California State Railroad Museum concession opportunity at Old Sacramento State Historic Park, in Sacramento County. A public meeting will be held on Monday, October 3, 2005 at 6:00 p.m. at the California State Railroad Museum Theater, 125 "I" Street, Sacramento, California.

This meeting is to solicit public input and ideas to help determine the future development and operation of the concession. The information gathered may be used in the preparation of a Request for Proposals or other process to obtain a contract.

Old Sacramento State Historic Park is comprised of nine acres along the Sacramento River within Old Sacramento Historic District in downtown Sacramento, not far from the interchange of Interstate 5 and Highway 50. The park depicts the American period of California history, portraying the Gold Rush and Sacramento's early urban and industrial development. The California State Railroad Museum, the most visited railroad museum in North America, is the centerpiece of the park. Veranda-covered boardwalks connect historic storefronts, restaurants, and museums throughout the Old Sacramento Historic District depicting Sacramento as it appeared during the Gold Rush. Within the park, several historic buildings have been reconstructed to add to the ambiance and interpretive value of the park.
