Lake Natoma's Negro Bar Boat Ramp Closes For Improvements August 15

FOLSOM – One of the most popular day-use areas at Lake Natoma is being renovated. By spring, Negro Bar will have a public restroom, a courtesy dock, a parking lot and a new boat ramp.

During the renovation, the boat ramp will be closed, but the swim beach, picnic area, group campground, and equestrian staging areas at Negro Bar will all remain open.

“We hope our visitors can excuse the inconvenience of having the boat ramp closed while these great improvements are being completed,” said Park Superintendent Michael Gross who heads the Folsom Lake State Recreation Area, which includes Lake Natoma, Folsom Lake and the Folsom Powerhouse State Historic Park.

The area is being renovated with funding provided by the California Department of Boating and Waterways.

Alternate launch facilities for Lake Natoma are available at Willow Creek and Nimbus Flat. Motorized watercraft can launch at Willow Creek and travel upstream. Non-motorized watercraft can launch at Willow Creek or Nimbus Flat.
