## State Historical Resources Commission Considers Additions to Registry

National Register of Historic Places applications that are scheduled for action include:

**Cowell Lime Works Historic District**      **Santa Cruz**      **Santa Cruz County**  
*Buildings made of wood and limestone mark area's history of quarrying*

**Highway 152 Tree Row**      **Gilroy**      **Santa Clara County**  
*A row of trees planted in celebration of California's first Arbor Day in 1930.*

**Ramos Sherry House/Depot Saloon**      **St. Helena**      **Napa County**  
*Home of John Ramos, built in 1880, contributed to the Sherry-making industry in CA*

**Roosevelt Building (Built in 1927)**      **Los Angeles**  
*Built in 1927, it embodies characteristics of the 1800s Italian Renaissance Revival style*

**Southwest Museum (Amendment)**      **Los Angeles**  
*An example of the Spanish Colonial Revival style designed by architect Sumner Hunt*

**Coyote Canyon Wild Horse Historic Dist.**      **Borrego Springs**      **San Diego County**  
*Contains a broad range of historic and cultural associations with wild and tame horses.*

**Cuyamaca Village/Ah-ha Kwe-ah-mac'**      **San Diego**      **San Diego County**  
*Associated with two Native American cultural events important to the tribal community*

California Register of Historical Resources nominations scheduled for removal action include:

**Naval Weapons Station Seal Beach**      Seal Beach      Orange County  
*World War II-era resources were ineligible when the properties were listed.*
