*Nominated for significance in demonstrating the architectural evolution of a Berkeley school*

**Board of Trade Building**                      **Berkeley**                      **Alameda County**  
*An example of a Beaux Art style commercial building with Neoclassical influences*

**Bono's Restaurant and Deli**                      **Fontana (Vicinity)**                      **San Bernardino County**  
*A significant example of commercial property associated with the development of Route 66*

**Carmel Valley Road-Boronda Eucalyptus Trees**                      **Carmel Valley**                      **Monterey County**  
*Historic tree row significant in the area of landscape architecture*

**Colombo Building**                      **San Francisco**                      **San Francisco County**  
*Associated with Elise Drexler, an early 20<sup>th</sup> century female entrepreneur and developer*

**Hagemann Ranch Historic District**                      **Livermore**                      **Alameda County**  
*A rare surviving example of Livermore Valley's early farmstead architecture*

**Lillian Coit Memorial Tower**                      **San Francisco**                      **San Francisco County**  
*Significant for the P.W.A.P. murals depicting California's diversity*

**Martinez City Library**                      **Martinez**                      **Contra Costa County**  
*Nominated as a local example of the Art Deco style*

**Pisgah Home Historic District**                      **Los Angeles**                      **Los Angeles County**  
*Associated with development of faith-based social services in Los Angeles*

*A locally significant prehistoric coastal shell midden site containing cultural remains extending back 6,000 years*
