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Statewide Recreational Trails Committee to Meet in Sacramento

Monday, December 3rd, 2012

The California Recreational Trails Committee will hold a **final** public meeting in Sacramento on December 3rd, 2012. This committee is scheduled to sunset in January 2013. The committee consists of seven Governor-appointed members representing all portions of the State. They are charged with hearing the concerns and issues of California's trail users and managers. The committee advises the Director of California State Parks and the Governor's office on trail issues. For more information, visit the website at www.parks.ca.gov/trails.

The public meeting will begin at 9:00 AM at the Resources Building 1st Floor Auditorium, 1416—9th Street, Sacramento, CA 95814. The Committee will finalize any open business, discuss the future of statewide trail coordination, and receive an update on the Statewide Programmatic Environmental Impact Report for Roads and Trails Change In Use.
