Columbia Hotels and Cottages Now Available for Reservation

The Fallon and City Hotels in Columbia State Historic Park are now available for reservation through the California State Parks ReserveAmerica system. The new concession operator, Briggs Hospitality LLC, reopened the hotels and newly restored cottages in June.

“We are excited to have the opportunity to provide these wonderful, historic facilities to visitors to enhance their Park experience,” says Jackie Briggs. This is the first time cottages have been available to the public for rent in Columbia State Historic Park. The three cottages, consisting of one, two, and three bedrooms, have an old-fashioned theme complete with some antique pieces and full kitchens.

Columbia State Historic Park offers a unique blend of museums, displays, town tours, live theater, and shops. Motorized vehicles are not allowed on the streets so families can explore the historic setting in safety and comfort. A visit to the City Hotel or Fallon Hotel is a glimpse into one of the most fascinating periods of America's history, as well as one of California's finest restorations. Columbia is central to various Mother Lode and Sierra attractions such as Yosemite National Park, Railtown 1897 State Historic Park, and Calaveras Big Trees State Park.
