Women's Victory Day at Colonel Allensworth State Historic Park on Saturday, March 24

Colonel Allensworth State Historic Park will celebrate Women's Victory Day on Saturday, March 24th from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. The park is the site of the only California town founded, financed and governed by African Americans. The park is approximately 42 miles northwest of Bakersfield.

The event is a day designed to honor the achievements of African American women. The Allensworth Women's Auxiliary, in conjunction with Colonel Allensworth State Historic Park, is presenting this 3rd annual celebration.

Activities include entertainment, Dr. Rose Milligan and other guest speakers; and the presentation of a new play "Liberty Banner" written and directed by Flosie Allen. Special activities for children will be held at the Children's Pavilion.

Park fees for the event are: \$2 per car; \$1 for seniors; \$10 for buses with up to 25 passengers; \$20 for buses with 25 passengers or more. Tours and programs are free.
