





This Conservation System conserves, protects, and restores some of America's most spectacular landscapes as a part of the agency's multiple use mandate. Consisting of about 27 million acres of public lands congressionally and presidentially set aside for their recreational, cultural, scientific, and other values, the Conservation System has over 850 National Monuments, National Conservation Areas, Wilderness, Wilderness Study Areas, Wild and Scenic Rivers, and National Scenic and Historic Trails. BLM Colorado manages 65 Conservation System areas encompassing over 1 million acres—about 1/8 of the 8.3 million acres of BLM land in the state.



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Location of the Kokopelli's Bike Trails


