PROJECT TITLE: Fence Installation and Replacement at Marina State Beach
LOCATION: Marina State Beach
COUNTY: Monterey

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install wood fencing at state residence and replace nearby dilapidated wire fence with split-rail fence at Marina State Beach for privacy and to delineate State property boundary. Work will remove approximately 90 ft of wire fence near the residence and replace with approximately 70 ft of 6 ft high redwood fence and a gate in front of the residence. Additional work will replace approximately 130 ft of wire fence along the park boundary with a split-rail fence. All fence posts holes will be manually excavated approximately 36” deep to install fence posts in concrete.
