PROJECT TITLE: Camp Host Site Development

LOCATION: Sugar Pine Point, D.L. Bliss and Emerald Bay State Parks COUNTY: El Dorado

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install power, water and sewage hook-ups to code and construct to Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards to five existing campsites to develop additional campground host sites at Sugar Pine Point, D.L. Bliss, and Emerald Bay State Parks. All sites: pour a 2' x 3' concrete slab to grade at each site and install a 30 amp RV pedestal for hook-ups adjacent to parking spur. Excavate all electrical trenches approximately 1' W x 24" deep; sewer and water approximately 1'W x 18" deep; lateral sewer lines 4" in diameter; bed trenches with sand and backfill with original soils to grade. Tie in all services to the pedestal. Additional work at individual sites will:

- Sugar Pine Point State Park site # 123 - Excavate approximately 20' L to install 3/4" galvanized water line from the existing water source. Excavate approximately 78' to install 2" electrical conduit from the restroom. Excavate 90' to install sewer line from the main sewer service line.
- D.L. Bliss State Park Site #141 - Excavate approximately 15' to install 3/4" galvanized water line from the existing water source. Excavate approximately 180' to install 2" electrical conduit from the restroom. Excavate approximately 100' to install sewer line from the main sewer service. Move three rocks to provide RV access.
- D.L. Bliss State Park former Chaplain Site - Excavate approximately 15' to install 3/4" galvanized water line from the existing water source. Excavate approximately 54' to install 2" electrical conduit from the existing electrical source. Excavate approximately 100' to install sewer line from the main sewer service. Install approximately 17' x 40' long parking spur with approximately 4" of wood chips. Move one rock and remove two small trees less than 14" in diameter to provide RV access.
- D.L. Bliss State Park former overflow site across from the group camp site. Excavate approximately 72' to install 3/4" galvanized water line from the existing water source. Excavate approximately 82' to install 2" electrical conduit to existing power source. Excavate approximately 72' to install sewer line from the main sewer service. Construct an approximate 40' x 10' parking spur; compact with road base. Remove 8 trees (white firs and one lodge pole pine) less than 12" in diameter for parking area.
- Emerald Bay State Park, Eagle Point Campground Site #9 - Excavate approximately 55' to install 3/4" galvanized water line from the existing water source. Excavate approximately 100' to install 2" electrical conduit from the lift station. Excavate approximately 55' to install sewer line from the main sewer service. Move two rocks to provide RV access.
- Construct a 40' long x 10' wide parking area; pack with a surface substrate of road base to accommodate up to approximately eight vehicles for group camp. The parking area will be located on the east side of the campground road directly adjacent to the group camp site.
