PROJECT TITLE: Residence Removal

LOCATION: Castle Rock State Park

COUNTY: Santa Cruz

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Remove uninhabitable residence located in Castle Rock State Park lower varien camping area for visitor safety. (The structure will be dismantled using an excavator and the construction debris will be placed into 30 yard dumpsters and hauled off of state property. The construction debris will be separated from concrete materials and be disposed of in compliance with local disposal guidelines. The area will be rehabilitated back to a natural landscape in accordance with resource standards.)

Work will dismantle 30 foot by 30 foot dilapidated structure using an excavator. Debris will be placed in 30 yard dumpsters and hauled off state park property for appropriate disposal. Additional work will include grading the disturbed soils back to a natural state and covered with natural duff material to rehabilitate the area to natural conditions.
