PROJECT TITLE: Issue Right of Entry to Marin County

LOCATION: Samuel P. Taylor State Park **COUNTY:** Marin

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Issue a Right of Entry (ROE) permit to Marin County to enter Samuel P. Taylor State Park to allow hand crews access for construction activity within the existing Sir Francis Drake Boulevard right-of-way for construction of roadway and drainage repairs as outlined on construction drawings referenced as Rehabilitation of Sir Francis Drake Boulevard, Phase 1B – From Irving Bridge to Shafter Bridge dated 8/10/2012. Permit also allows for the construction of temporary erosion control on State Park land necessary for watershed protection during construction activities and as required by the roadway repair project environmental documents and permits.

All work conducted in association with the Right of Entry will comply with all State and Federal environmental laws, including but not limited to the Endangered Species Act, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and Section 5024 of the Public Resources Code, Marin County will notify DPR if any new historical resources (including archaeological sites), special status species, Threatened/Endangered Species, or other resource issues are identified within the area.


