PROJECT TITLE: Barn Stabilization

LOCATION: Wilder Ranch State Park

COUNTY: Santa Cruz

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Stabilize and rehabilitate the historic barn at Wilder Ranch State Park to preserve and maintain a cultural resource that was until recently used as a shooting range for State Park Peace Officers. Work will manually remove creek sediments from the interior and exterior of the barn; install 8" by 8" redwood mudsill foundation and add 2' by 12' redwoods boards at the base walls; install a 2' by 6' foot redwood framing and anchor to the foundation with lag bolts; repair or replace siding as needed with 1" by 4" batten siding; repair roof with 1" by 8" redwood board on board roofing covered with wood shingles on the front portion and galvanized corrugated metal on the rear of the building; install a French drain with 3/4" drain rock and 4" perforated drain piping, rock will be wrapped with filter fabric and covered with excavated soil; and install a new galvanized steel stovepipe roof jack and redwood rain gutters.. Use matching existing construction techniques, materials and sized using redwood grade construction heart at a minimum to complete all repairs "in Kind" as needed..
