DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Connect the failing water system to the city of Brentwood's municipal water service in Marsh Creek State Park to provide clean water. Work will install a water meter, backflow device, and approximately 125 feet of above ground piping.

Additional work will separate the well from the closed loop water system with an above ground cap.


