LOCATION: Natural Bridges State Beach

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Replace thirteen (13) interpretive panels located in Natural Bridges State Beach to provide interpretation of natural resources in the park. Work will:

- Remove existing signage and old posts; haul off and recycle.
- Excavate 11 holes; 6" wide by 36" deep 11 holes
- Place 3" by 3" by 96" powder-coated aluminum post into holes
- Set posts with cement.
- Install 13 panels:
 - o 2 - 32" by 21"
 - o 2 - 40" by 32"
 - o 2 - 36" by 24"
 - o 5 - 24" by 12"
 - o 2 - 48" by 24"
- All signs will be install at 32" above the ground


