DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Remove, repair and repaint the Fire House on Angel Island State Park to preserve the structural integrity of the building. Work will:

- Remove and replace approximately 200 square feet of ship lap siding with identical material;
- Remove loose and flaking lead based paint;
- Repair or replace in kind approximately 450 lineal feet of 1"x4 damaged wood trim,
- Remove and rebuild an estimated 8 double hung windows with identical material,
- Apply new undercoat and paint.

Hazardous lead paint materials will be removed and properly disposed of in accordance with all local, state and federal laws.
