**PROJECT TITLE:** Central and Kitchen Building Re-roof

**LOCATION:** Sutter's Fort State Historic Park

**COUNTY:** Sacramento

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** Re-roof the historic Central Building and kitchen at Sutter's Fort State Historic Park to maintain and protect a Cultural Resource. At the Central Building work will remove the existing, failing, non-historic roof; install plywood sheathing on top of the existing framing to strengthen the roof diaphragm with new fascia board to cover the plywood; install light gauge metal strips aligned with the rafters over the ridge to transfer shear; install combination shear and tension anchors and blocking and strapping to deliver seismic shear and tension loads (central building); install new cedar shakes; and replace rain gutters. At the Kitchen, work will remove the existing, failing, non-historic roof; repair and/or replace plywood sheathing, roof framing, fascia, flashing, rain gutters and leader(s), as needed; install 1/2" plywood CDX sheathing over the existing 1x12" sheathing along the rafter layout, place/seal grace ice and water shield on top of plywood substrate; and install new cedar shakes. DPR-approved standard project requirements have been incorporated into the Central Building Re-roof Project. **REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:** Project consists of the repair, maintenance and minor alteration of an existing public structure involving no expansion of use beyond current levels; replacement of existing structure where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced and is included as "reroofing" in the California Department of Parks and Recreation's list of exempt activities in accordance with CCR §15300.4 and consists of the maintenance, repair and stabilization of historical resources in a manner consistent with *the Secretary of Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties with Guidelines for Preserving, Rehabilitating, Restoring and Reconstructing Historic Buildings (1995)* Weeks and Grimmer.


