DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Perform maintenance work on the state owned residence at 22925 Columbia Street in Columbia State Historic Park to allow for continued use as a rental. Work will:

- remove and replace in-kind, as needed, 13 existing deteriorated wood sash windows and screens,
- remove and replace in-kind, as needed, 3 exterior doors, door casings, heads, jambs, and miscellaneous wood trim,
- remove dry wall on kitchen ceiling, replace insulation and replace drywall
- remove wood shingle roof on main part of house, install 1/2" OSB underlayment, apply 30 lb. felt and install new asphalt shingles;
- remove gutters and downspouts and replace with new 5: Ogee galvanized steel gutters and downspouts;
- install roof mounted evaporative cooler; associated water/electrical lines, and ductwork; cut opening in living room ceiling for new register and attach new ductwork.

Additional work will excavate no more than 3.5 cubic yards of material to recontour the ground on the east and north sides of the residence, and excavate a maximum of 8.15 cubic yards of material to install French drains to protect house from water intrusion..
