PROJECT TITLE: Signs for Bixel Brewery

LOCATION: Columbia State Historic Park

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install three signs for a new concessionaire at 22801 Main Street in Columbia State Historic Park to help visitors identify the establishment. Two signs will be installed on two sides of the building parapet. One will measure 3' x 24', the other 3' x 20'. Both will be made of wood and hung on the parapet with metal brackets and be secured to the building mortar between bricks. Lettering will be black and gold on a white background stating "Bixel Brewery at the St. Charles". The third sign will be a wine barrel cut in half and placed on the corner of the building between the other two signs and will have the words "Food & Drink". It will be affixed with metal brackets hanging over the parapet and secured to the building mortar.


