PROJECT TITLE: Camp Host Site Improvements

LOCATION: Fort Humboldt State Historic Park **COUNTY:** Humboldt

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Improve the camp host site at Fort Humboldt State Historic Park to improve accessibility for a host trailer, reduce the need for leveling actions of a host, and make their sewer connection easier to hook up and un-hook.

Work will:

- Install approximately 10 cubic yards of level and compacted road base atop existing soils to create a level parking pad approximately 10' wide by 40' length, slightly crowned (1%) for drainage.
- Taper edge of gravel cap to gentle slope to match existing grade of lawn with additional 24" to 36" width on each side, additional 48" to 60" length at rear (south) end of pad. North end of pad will match existing grade.
- Install connection to existing sewer line to eliminate above ground exposed sewer pipe. Excavate a trench up to 12" wide x 24" deep, 12' in length to existing sewer pipe. Install riser with threaded cap to slightly above grade (less than 1") of surrounding ground. Connect riser to exiting sewer line at 2% slope for drainage of connected sewer discharge.



REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: Project consists of the repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond current levels, replacement or reconstruction of existing structures where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced, construction and location of limited numbers of new structures, and minor alterations in the condition of land, and/or vegetation which does not involve the removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees, and is included as "construction or installation of park facilities such as camp host sites" in the Department of Parks and Recreation's list of exempt activities, in accordance with CCR § 15300.4.
