DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Remove 70 feet of exterior non-historic mine structure and sloughed material at the entrance of the Eureka Mine to improve public safety. Re-useable timbers will be identified and stored on site for future use; damaged material will be taken off site and disposed. Removed slough material will be placed in the borrow pit on the Madora Lake Road. Post and install safety sign on existing gate to inform park visitors that the mine entrance is restricted.
