PROJECT TITLE: Gate House Fence

LOCATION: Samuel P. Taylor State Park **COUNTY:** Marin

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Reconstruct and add to existing fence at the Gate House residence at Samuel P. Taylor State Park to provide security and privacy for the residents. Work will:

- Reconstruct approximately 170 feet of deteriorated wood board fencing;
- Remove approximately 100 feet of wire fencing surrounding the yard on the west side of the house and construct approximately 100 lineal feet of six foot high wood board fencing in the same alignment.
- To the extent possible, utilize existing post hole; new/additional holes will be no more than 36" in depth and 12" in diameter.
