LOCATION: Grizzly Creek Redwoods State Park
COUNTY: Humboldt

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install antennae and associated components to access internet service at Grizzly Creek Redwoods State Park to increase communication capability. Work will:

- Attach a 14" diameter, 2 lb., metal and plastic antennae and associated components to a redwood tree approximately 150 feet from the ground.
- Attach the antennae to the tree using a metal standoff bracket; 3" lag bolts will secure the bracket to the tree.
- Attach the cable to the tree using clips that have single screws; continue cable run along an adjacent fence, and into the park office.


