PROJECT TITLE: Social Hall Doors and Windows Repair and Replacement
LOCATION: Asilomar State Beach and Conference Grounds
COUNTY: Monterey

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Repair and replace doors and windows at the Phoebe Hearst Social Hall at Asilomar State Beach and Conference Grounds to preserve and protect the facility and to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Work will:

- Remove four worn entry doors, frames, and hardware and replace with new doors, frames and hardware matching existing in type, style, size, and material. Two of the new doors will be accessible; the two non-accessible entries will have signage installed directing visitors to the accessible entries;
- Remove one worn door at Phoebe’s Café and replace with Dutch door matching existing in type, size, and material; and
- Repair and/or replace as necessary five window frames matching existing in type, style, size, and material.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

Project consists of repair of existing historic resources in a manner consistent with the Secretary of the Interior’s Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties with Guidelines for Preserving, Rehabilitating, Restoring, and Reconstructing Historic Buildings (1995), Weeks and Grimmer and the repair or minor alteration of existing structures or features involving no expansion beyond current use and is included as "modifications of existing facilities for access for people with disabilities" in the Department of Parks and Recreation’s list of exempt activities, in accordance with CCR § 15300.4.
