PROJECT TITLE: Facility Repair and Roof Replacement at the Vallejo Home Complex

LOCATION: Sonoma State Historic Park

COUNTY: Sonoma

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Repair interior/exterior features and replace the General Vallejo home and kitchen/cookhouse roofs at Sonoma State Historic Park to maintain and preserve cultural resources. Work will:

- Stabilize and replace the fallen, water-damaged and un-keyed ceiling plaster and repair cracks in the wall plaster in the volunteer room;
- Repair or replace in-kind the weather damage on the tall bay window(s);
- Remove, repair down to framing/replace in-kind and repaint the wood window shutters;
- Replace in-kind all flashing at the chimneys, dormers, siding and valleys.

Additional work will prepare a preliminary engineering analysis and a set of updated building drawings of the Chalet brick structure.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

Project consists of repair and maintenance of existing public facilities involving no expansion of use beyond current levels; replacement of existing structures where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced and is included as "reroofing" in the Department of Parks and Recreation's list of exempt activities in accordance with CCR § 15300.4 and maintenance and repair of historical resources in a manner consistent with the *Secretary of Interior Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties with Guidelines for Preserving, Rehabilitating, Restoring and Reconstructing Historic Buildings (1995)*, Weeks and Grimmer.
