DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install directional sign at the entrance to the Eel River Sector Office in Humboldt Redwoods State Park to direct visitors to the nearby visitor center. Work will:

- Dig two, two feet deep by four inch across, holes in the level grass area on the right side of the driveway to the sector office.
- Install a sign measuring 52 inches across and 26 inches high.
