PROJECT TITLE: Generator Replacement

LOCATION: Pfeiffer Big Sur State Park

COUNTY: Monterey

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Replace an existing non-functioning diesel generator with a new propane-powered generator and accessory facilities in the generator shed behind Warden's Garage in Pfeiffer Big Sur State Park. Work will:

- Install new generator in existing shed modified to accommodate new generator by installing pair of 3' double doors and air intake and exhaust screens;
- Excavate a 4' X 10' X 4" deep area and install a concrete pad, and install new 499 gallon propane tank;
- Excavate approximately 20' of trenches, 12" wide by 24" deep to install steel pipe connecting propane tank and generator;
- Excavate a 36' X 4' X 4" deep area and install a concrete pathway around shed;
- Install approximate 40' X 4' decomposed granite walkway; and
- Excavate approximately 7 post holes 30" deep x 18" in diameter and install 35LF of 6' high redwood privacy fencing with 4' wide gate around propane tank.


REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

Project consists of the repair and maintenance of existing public facilities, involving negligible expansion of use beyond current levels; replacement or reconstruction of existing facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity; and minor public alterations in the condition of land, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees; included as "above-ground fuel tanks" and fencing and gates" in the Department of Parks and Recreation's list of exempt activities, in accordance with CCR § 15300.4.
