LOCATION: Anderson Marsh State Historic Park **COUNTY:** Lake

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: This Project will install one gate across an existing road within the Anderson Marsh State Historic Park for emergency services access and resource protection. Work will:

- Excavate 2 post holes by hand;
- Place concrete in holes to secure gate posts;
- Excavate 2 sign posts by hand on either side of gate and install signs, no concrete used;
- Place large, currently existing boulders along both sides of gate, further restricting public vehicular access.
