PROJECT TITLE: Lake Clementine Boat Ramp Repairs

LOCATION: Lower Lake Clementine, Auburn State Recreation Area

COUNTY: Placer

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Make repairs to the Lake Clementine Boat Ramp at Auburn State Recreation Area for visitor to facilitate boat launching and loading during low lake water. Work will fill the holes at the end of the ramp with clean crushed rock and rip-rap and extend the concrete ramp 13 feet in length with a pre-manufactured concrete ARMORFLEX ramp mat anchored with rebar. Dredge approximately 39 cubic yards of existing silt and rip-rap to prepare the site for installing the ARMORFLEX ramp. Fifteen cubic yards of the dredged rip-rap will be re-used in addition to 17 cubic yards of imported clean crushed rock for ARMORFLEX ramp base and infill. The ARMORFLEX ramp extension will be 13 feet long and 30 feet wide (the same width as the existing launch ramp). If possible, the lake will be lowered in consultation with the Army Corps of Engineers in order to dewater the construction area. If not, prior to any work occurring below the high water level, a turbidity curtain and other BMPs will be installed around the perimeter of the work area to contain siltation.



REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

Project consists of minor alteration of existing public boat launch facility and topographical features, involving negligible expansion of use beyond current levels; new construction to extend the existing boat launch facility; and minor alterations in the condition of land and water (temporarily) that will not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees and is included as "boat launching facilities" in the Department of Parks and Recreation's list of exempt activities, in accordance with CCR §15300.4.
