**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:**

Replace 55 existing non-animal proof wooden food lockers with animal proof metal food storage lockers located at the Little Basin property within Big Basin Redwood State Park.

**Work will:**

- Remove 55 wooden food lockers;
- Dig a hole approximately 12" inches wide by 22" deep;
- Attach the galvanized pole to the each container with a U-Bolt;
- Level container and place pole in the ground;
- Pour two bags of cement into each hole to secure container.


