PROJECT TITLE: Water System Improvement

LOCATION: Burlleigh H. Murray Ranch

COUNTY: San Mateo

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install a 4900 gallon domestic water tank, a fire hydrant and necessary electrical connections at Burlleigh H. Murray State Park to provide water for fire suppression and residential use.

Work will:

- Excavate approximately six (6) to eight (8) inches in depth to level a fourteen (14) foot diameter area;
- Construct a fourteen (14) by fourteen (14) foot wood frame to hold compacted gravel base for the water tank;
- Install 4900 gallon HDPE tank on gravel base;
- Install an ozone filter in the water tank;
- Trench six (6) inches wide by thirty-six (36) inches deep and fifty (50) feet in length to install a water line to connect to the existing water system and new fire hydrant;
- Install a Christy box with valves;
- Trench six (6) inches wide by thirty-six (36) inches deep and fifty (50) feet in length to install electrical line for the pump house to the electrical panel located at the resident housing;
- Pour a 4' by 4' x 4' concrete pad;
- Construct a 4' x 4' x 7' pump house; clad with T-1-11 siding and roof with composition shingles.
- Install a pressure tank, pump and Ozone generator into the pump house.
- Install a new fire hydrant
