PROJECT TITLE: Water Pipeline Expansion

LOCATION: Big Basin Redwoods State Park

COUNTY: Santa Cruz

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Install water hydrant to the existing potable water pipeline at the Little Basin property within Big Basin Redwoods State Park to bring the park unit into compliance with the fire code per the State Fire Marshall and to protect natural resources and the public. Work will:

Hydrant Installation

- Excavate a 4' x 4' x 24" deep hole to uncover existing 6" water pipeline;
- Install a 6" x 6" x 4" tee;
- Excavate a trench approximately 20' long by 18" wide and approximately 4' deep;
- Install approximately 20 feet of 4" PVC pipe, a valve and a fire hydrant;
- Pressure test and leak test the water hydrant;
- Back fill with excavated dirt and compact to existing grade.

Pump and Motor Installation

- Pour a 4' x 4' x 4" concrete pad;
- Set the pump and motor onto the concrete pad;
- Connect the pump to the house water supply line.


REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:
