PROJECT TITLE: Vikingsholm Courtyard Foyer Floor Repair

LOCATION: Emerald Bay State Park

COUNTY: El Dorado

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Repair the structural support system under the flagstone entry floor located in the Vikingsholm Courtyard Foyer, in Emerald Bay State Park, to increase public and employee safety. Work will:

- Cover walls, ceiling, curtain and stairwell near the foyer with plastic to protect from construction debris.
- Remove flagstone floor documenting order of placement.
- Remove sub-floor; inspect extent of damage to floor joists; remove rotted and damaged material.
- Install horizontal supports to support the side lights and door after floor removal.
- Replace and/or repair all rotten floor joists, rim joists, plate and sill.
- Install new sub-floor.
- Install new threshold matching the original including area under both side windows next to the door.
- Lay protective moisture barrier on sub-floor to insulate and protect floor from mortar.
- Re-install flagstone on sub-floor in original pattern and location.
- Re-grout and seal flagstone; remove temporary support posts.
