PROJECT TITLE: Dishwashing Stations Retrofit

LOCATION: Big Basin Redwoods State Park

COUNTY: Santa Cruz

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Retrofit restroom buildings by installing three dishwashing stations in an effort to prevent the wildlife from having access to food residue in the campsites due to dishwashing at the French Drains located within Big Basin Redwoods State Park.
Work will:

Jay Camp and Lower Huckleberry Restroom Combo Buildings:

- Demo existing exterior sink base;
- Pour concrete slab – 24" wide x 6' length x 4" deep;
- Construct counter base with 2" x 4" redwood boards 24" deep, 6' in length, 2 ft., 9 1/2" in height;
- Install countertop, plumbing fixtures and connections and electrical;

Huckleberry Tent Cabin Combo Building:

- Demo and haul away existing concrete sidewalk;
- Excavate soil 9' x 12' area, approximately 4" deep and pour concrete slab;
- Construct two exterior walls 2 x4 construction with TJ11 siding to match existing; Construct counter base with 2" x 4" redwood boards 24" deep, 6' in length, 2 ft., 9 1/2" in height;
- Install countertop, plumbing fixtures and connections, electrical and batons.


REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:
