PROJECT TITLE: Maintenance Office Septic Tank

LOCATION: Big Basin Redwoods State Park

COUNTY: Santa Cruz

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install a new 1500 gallon septic tank and three leach lines at the Maintenance Shop located within Big Basin Redwoods State Park to improve employee facilities.

Work will:

- Excavate a hole eight (8) feet deep and six (6) feet wide by eight (8) feet long;
- Install new septic tank;
- Trench two (2) feet deep and eight (8) inches wide by sixty (60) feet long;
- Pour 3/4" base rock into the trench, two (2) inches deep;
- Install distribution box, leach lines and clean out ports and connect to the new septic tank;
- Back fill excavated soil over the septic tanks and new leach lines;
- Spread two (2) inch layer of asphalt patching over the septic tank and leach fields to repair the parking lot;
- Haul all excavated spoils off-site.


